

Learning Activities: Sensory Impairments

In-Class Activity: Vision-Friendly Learning Environment Design

Objective:

Students will apply clinical and functional knowledge of low vision to adapt a preschool classroom for a child with low vision.

Instructions:

1. Present a brief case study of a child with low vision (e.g., diagnosed with albinism, has light sensitivity and reduced acuity).
2. In small groups, students will:
 - Identify potential barriers in a typical classroom (lighting, layout, materials).
 - Propose **specific adaptations** using strategies from Corn & Erin, 2010.
